Reporting to (position):	Divan Supervisor
Hours of Work:	Monday – Thursday 6am - 2.15pm, Friday 6am – 1pm.

Job Objectives:

Wrap the finished product in the Divan/Headboard section ensuring work is visually checked to match the production order.

Main Duties::

Visually check the finished product: ensuring the ticket and item match.
Ensure all relevant extras are added: castors, legs, glides, Headboard bolts and stickers.
Scan the finished products as wrapped.
Working with Team Leader: ensure the work is wrapped to the correct priority and on time.
Ensure housekeeping is to the correct standard throughout the shift.
Reporting any issues to the team leader
Meet the required output demand
Assist other operatives with lifting when required.
Any other duties deemed necessary.
